## Mississippi Delta Community College employees to shelter in place

In light of Governor Tate Reeves Executive Order No. 1466 which requires all Mississippi residents to shelter in place, all buildings at all MDCC campus locations will be closed effective April 3, 2020, at 5:00 p.m. until April 20, 2020 at 8:00 a.m.

The college will remain operational.

- Employees are to work from home unless otherwise directed by their supervisor.
- Classes will continue to be taught remotely.
- Remote priority registration will continue as scheduled.
- No employees should report to campus unless notified by your supervisor to do so or unless approved by your Vice President.

The MDCC Police Department will be notified by the division Vice President should any employees require campus building access. *Employees who must work on campus should practice social distancing, and no groups of 10 or more should gather at any time.*
