COVID-19: Constant sanitizing at all facilities is conducted daily to minimize the spread of COVID-19 at MDCC. Sanitation stations are placed throughout MDCC facilities. Telehealth Services: Mississippi Delta Community College has partnered with Delta Health System to offer telehealth services. Trojan Stockade: The Trojan Stockade is a food pantry available to all MDCC students to assist with food insecurity. It is stocked with various food items as well as hygiene products, laundry items, and more. The pantry is located at the southeast corner of the Stanny Sanders Library. The Trojan Stockade will re-open on January 18, 2023. The hours of operation are Mondays and Wednesdays from 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm. All students must complete an application before using the pantry and present a valid MDCC student ID when visiting.
