Upon completion of the Practical Nursing Program at Mississippi Delta Community College, the graduate should be able to

MDCC PN PASS RATE FOR NCLEX

The program's most recent annual licensure examination pass rate will be at least 70% for all test-takers during the same 12-month period.

2023 Graduates	68% for all takers. PN class of 2023 96% of the class pass boards (Staff looked at teaching strategies and testing to help students to understand the material. We looked at where students were deficient in those areas on the NCELX to help students to improve their testing scores.
